Remarks:

Option 1 Registered Mail*

- 2) Give a self-addressed envelope (23 x 32 cm. = A4) to the invigilator on the day of the test.
- 3) Write your **pay-in code (Ref. 1)**, which can be accessed online, on the bottom right corner of the envelope.

Option 2 Standard Mail**

- 1) Give a self-addressed envelope (23 x 32 cm. = A4) with a 3-baht stamp to the invigilator on the day of the test.
- 2) Write your **pay-in code (Ref. 1)**, which can be accessed online, on the bottom right corner of the envelope.

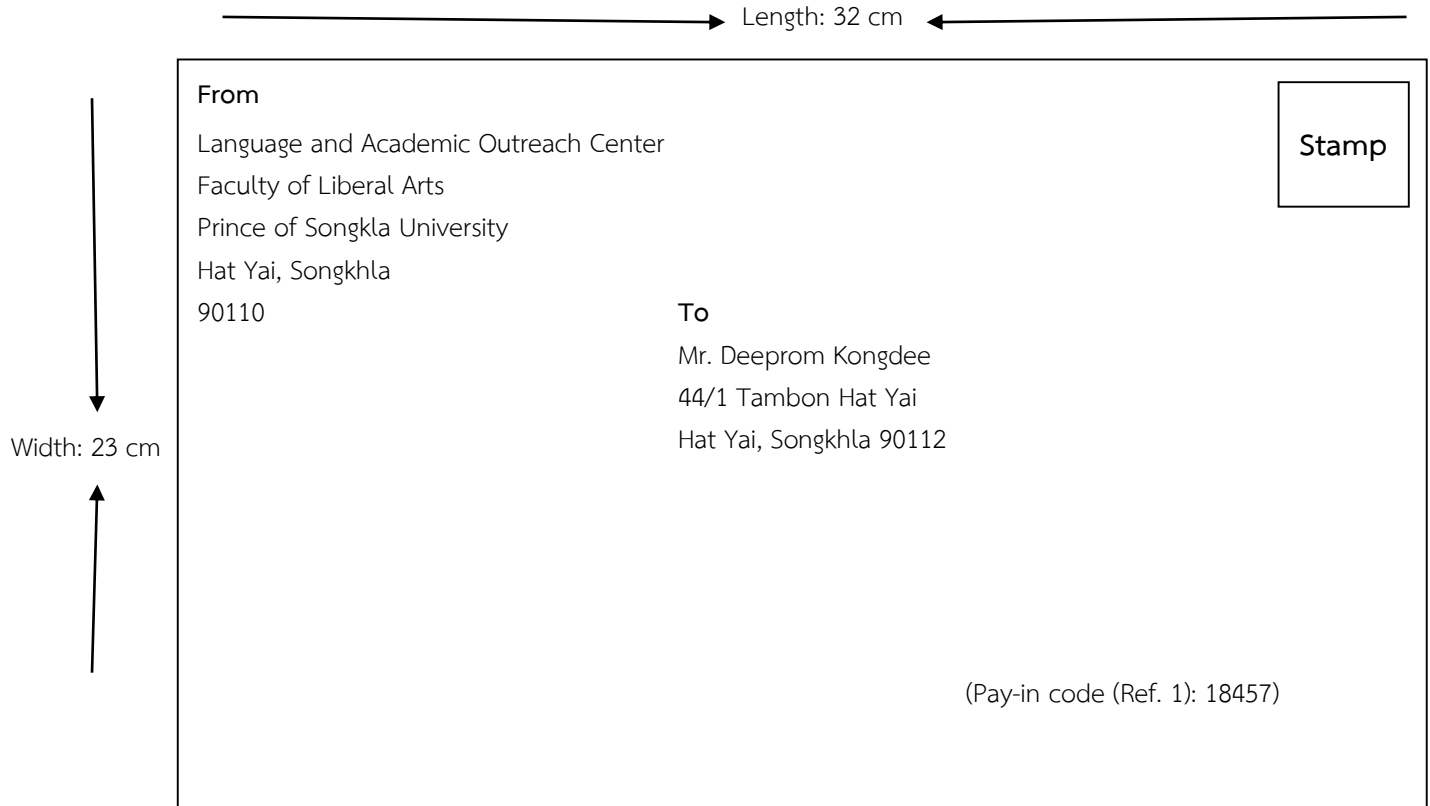
